Code of Conduct

Following requests from Members and in common with similar private members' clubs, the Board has decided to implement a Code of Conduct intended to enhance and promote the courteous traditions of Roehampton Club.

- a) At all times Members' conduct is expected to reflect the courteous spirit and traditions of Roehampton Club.
- b) Communications are expected to be open and factual.
- c) Email addresses obtained for fulfilling Club responsibilities may not be used for canvassing in elections or surveys.
- d) Unless arranging Club matches or events, Members may email no more than twenty other Members at any one time or on any subject. Chain emails or the mass forwarding of emails are against the spirit of these rules.
- e) Surveys may only be organised by the Chief Executive and at the request of and in consultation with the Committees.
- f) Written or electronic communications pertaining, in whole or part, to election or surveys must be copied to all candidates or the Chief Executive respectively.
- g) A Member who disagrees with a Committee decision is asked to write personally to the Chairman of that Committee. Petitions and group letters are discouraged.
- h) Negative campaigning (e.g. criticism or highlighting a certain candidate's merit in contrast to another's) would not be in the spirit of the Club.
- Results of all elections and surveys will be published both in the Club and on the website.
- j) A Member failing to provide an explanation for a breach of this Code which is not considered satisfactory by the Board, may be cautioned, required to apologise and/or required to issue a written retraction.
