### **Eclectic Opener Stableford Competition 14th March**

On 28th February the sign up opens for the above competition. It is a normal Stableford but it is also the first competition that counts for your eclectic score.

For those of you unfamiliar with the format, the Eclectic is a competition that runs from the spring through to the Autumn Meeting. Entrants submit a base Stableford score over 18 holes. Any improved scores on individual holes attained in a Stableford or medal will be automatically noted by Intelligent Golf and the base score upgraded. In addition, players can submit improvements from social rounds by emailing Matt Fidler, at [matt.fidler@roehamptonclub.co.uk](mailto:matt.fidler@roehamptonclub.co.uk), remembering to copy the playing partner into the message as a witness. Anyone unable to play on the 14th is still welcome to join in the fun by submitting an 18 hole score to Matt as described above. If anything is still unclear, please do message me for clarification.

You will need to sign up for the Stableford and the Eclectic separately, but both will be on Intelligent Golf. The cost to enter the eclectic is £5 and the proceeds will go to Age UK Wandsworth.
