Croquet Communique – 11th August 2023

7th World Croquet Federation Women's Golf Croquet World Championship

The WCF Women's G C World Championship featuring the top players from around the world is being held at Sussex County Croquet Club in Southwick near Brighton. Play is from 7th August to 14th August and involves 56 players from 16 countries.

I am delighted to report that Roehampton Club have two entrants – Diana Wilson is joined by Lynn Pearcy who had to play through three days of qualifying to gain her place.

Both Diana (Block A) and Lynn (Block B) started well in their matches.

Diana defeated top Egyptian, Manal Khodeir, 7-6, 7-6 and then Anne Lehmann from Germany, 7-4, 4-7, 7-6, in a closely fought match. She then went on to play the current world champion, and number one seed, Soha Moustafa, and, having lost the first game 7-1, she fought back strongly to take the second, 7-4. The match was paused overnight and resumed on Wednesday morning with Soha winning the deciding game, 7-3. Who knows what might have happened had the game continued without the overnight break, but it was a very creditable performance for Diana. Her next match was against Liz Farrow of England who, with the benefit of home advantage, won a very close match 6-7, 6-7.

Lynn began with a match against Ghada Karam from Egypt and scored a significant victory 7-4, 7-3. She then went on to defeat Simone Huber from Switzerland, 7-3, 7-2, before meeting Egyptian Amany Hassan, who proved too strong, and who took the game 7-1, 7-4. Her next match against Helena Jannson, from Finland, saw a return to winning ways with a 7-3, 4-7, 7-5 victory. Lynn then went on to play Jayne Stevens (UK) where she won a very close match 5-7, 7-6, 7-6. (Scores up to Wednesday 9th August evening)

They play six matches in their blocks with the top four progressing to the knockout stage
