The Winner of the Championship Cup

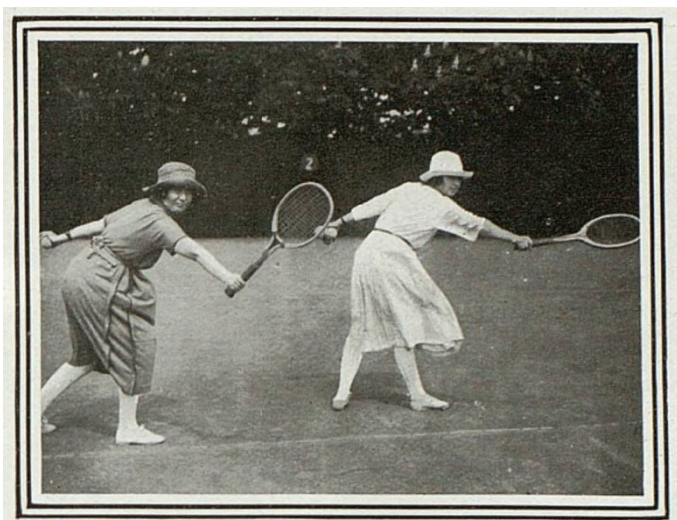

O'Callaghan (14) won the cup. H. Maxwell Browne (11), R. C. J. Beaton (11), K. H. Izard (10), H. F. W. Prince (10), E. A. S. Fawcett (8), Edgar Whitaker (7), C. J. D. Johnson (7), Mrs. E. C. G. Ashmore (6), O'Callaghan won seven games in each series.

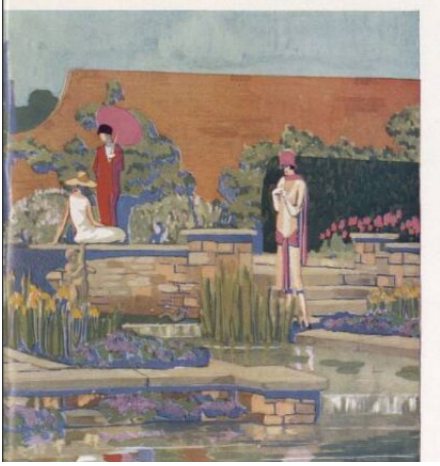

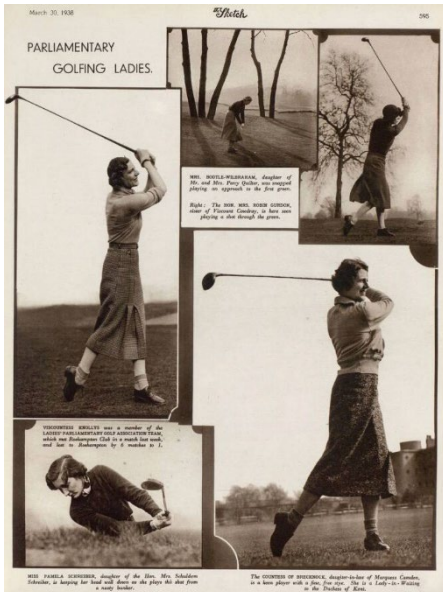
