Amazons of the Avant Garde – Russian women artists of the revolution

In the dizzying times of Russian revolutionary activity six pioneering women worked alongside men to make a new art for a Brave New World.

As the bold experiment ended those who had not moved to the West played out their lives in an increasingly harsh Soviet Union where their radical art was brutally proscribed.

This is a welcome return by Russian expert Lucrezia Walker, an Art Historian and author of twelve books on modern and contemporary art. She is a regular speaker at the National Gallery and a Professor of Art History.
