Date	Learning	Subject matter
18 September	Measurement recap. Overlaying. Bring pencils, charcoal, rubber, pastels 1 x cartridge A2 1 x pastel toned paper A2	1. Still life - measurement and line - pencil. 2. Rotating the elements. Charcoal and pastel overlay- semi abstraction.
25 th September	Atmospheric perspective Pastels and piece of charcoal and toned paper	Copying a pastel landscape noting pale colours to create depth.
2 October	Scaling up reminder or if you are confident go free hand	Copy a dog drawing, charcoal on paper plus white
9 October	One point perspective Bring Pastels	Copying a street scene using one point perspective

30 October	Colour mixing tonal values From photo provided Bring acrylics	Monochromatic still life one colour - purple, white and black - acrylic - photo image provided

6 November	Building up layers The more complex Boat images from last year. Bring watercolours and masking fluid and brushes	Watercolour - more complicated boat from last term using masking fluid, working in layers and learning about being patient for watercolour to dry!!
13 November	Acrylic paints	Palette knife painting - landscape
20 November	Still life in pastel from direct observation	Still life from Life. Bring some objects. Could be a pair of old boots or shoes. Does not always have to be fruit etc
27 November	Your own image to bring Make sure you have a range of values in the image and photocopy it into black and white, so you know you have a range! Watercolour	Bring your own landscape photo to paint in watercolour.
