### Week 1 - Monday, 20 January

This class will be taught by a Guest Tutor  
Charcoal tonal Landscape work  
The **Guest Tutor, John Dean** will choose his image to supply

### Week 2 - Monday, 27 January

Watercolour image  
**Daisy** will choose and supply her own landscape or still life to work from

### Week 3 - Monday, 3 February

Monochrome acrylic using one colour of choice plus black for shades and Titanium white for tints

### Week 4 - Monday, 10 February

Nude - life drawing ANDREA confirmed as model

Flower Pastel image (supplied) to copy - hatching strokes

### Week 8 – Monday, 17 March

Pastel landscape

***Materials List - YOU NEED TO BRING **all your own materials now** including cartridge paper pastel, toned paper, watercolour paper, acrylic paper and acrylic disposable palette paper-unless you are NEW STUDENT in which case you will be provided for.***

Pencils: 2B, 5B and a 9B Week 1

Putty Rubber week 1 and 2  
Hard Rubber week 1 and 2  
Willow charcoal assorted box or just get medium charcoal. All weeks  
Cartridge paper A2 sketch pad or A3 but not smaller Week 1 and 2 and 4  
1 x A2 sheet of Canson grey toned pastel paper week 4  
1 x soft white chalk pastel (week 4)  
Masking tape, all weeks  
Compass -Week 3  
Ruler - week 3

### **Paints and Acrylic work Week 3 and 5,**

Colour list:

Titanium white, lemon yellow, cadmium yellow, yellow ochre, vermilion or cadmium red, alizarin crimson, cerulean blue, ultramarine blue, raw or burn umber, ivory black

Box set is the way to go -

However box sets usually don't have the cerulean blue which you will need to buy separately. The black is usually mars or lamp black which is fine.
