Date	Subject
23 Jan Shaun Carey teaching	Glass, Glazing & Highlights – bring in an item or two of glassware eg bottle and wine glass or one glass, one other item plus coloured paper or cloth to place them on. Working from life. Looking at distortion of colour and shapes through glass Bring glazing medium! I will bring items & prints too.
30 Jan	 Managing the tools we work from Life with: Brushes: – Bring in different sized brushes from 40mm Round eg 'Chunky Monkey' by Coral (Amazon) to your smallest brush. Gesso – how to make the 'ground' or foundation of a painting. You will need 2 – 3 canvas, boards or acrylic paper. (Gesso will be provided for all). Bring 1 or 2 items for a still life eg fruit plus background cloth eg fruit. We will do 2 or 3 quick still lives using different sized brushes.
6 Feb	Fabrics and folds – how to really look and work with them. Starting from sketch to grisaille to colour. Working from life, drawings and prints. Bring in a cloth, fabric you like, plus an item to place upon it. Or part of an Old Master painting.
13 Feb	Palette knife – from mixing your paint to grattage and painting tool. It will be useful to have at least 2 palette knives: small trowel and larger knife. Landscape or seascape.
20 Feb	NO CLASS
27 Feb	Animals in art. Portrait of your pet or another. Cave paintings, Greek reliefs, Paolo Uccello, Stubbs and more. Bring in a photo, I will have prints.
6 Mar	1.Couples – children, adults or animals. Painting the people and the relationship. A chance to further your portrait studies.

13 Mar	2.Couples – continuing the study from last week or starting a new one!
20 Mar	Abstract: Enlarging a part of an existing painting or photograph to find shapes and form beyond a recognisable item or getting creative and finding what emerges from within you.
27 Mar	Work as you wish.
