<u>Materials</u> There are various makes of pastel sets. Jacksons' own brand are cheap and not very pigmenty, but do the job. Inscribe (link below) are very good value at the low budget end and are better; I recommend having a set PLUS another brand with even more pigment such as Rembrandt. Sennelier are a good top brand and are, of course, more expensive. Pastel Paper. Buy in a pad at Jacksons or Cass Art – A3 size is good: Canson or Ingres brands give assorted neutral colours. Or you can buy individual toned coloured sheets in A2 size and tear in half.
