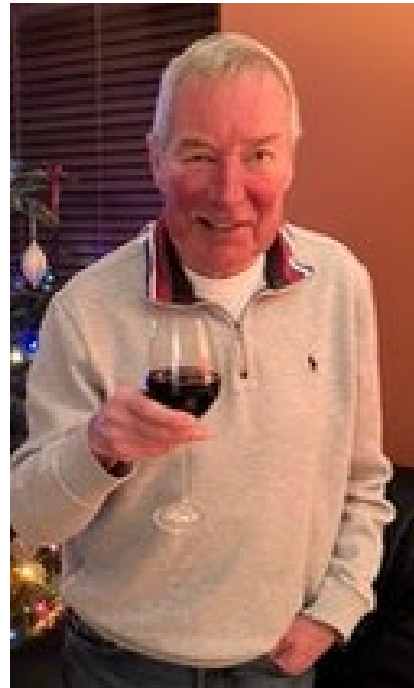


# DANNY WHIDDON
