IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Handicap Requirements

To maintain fairness in Trophy and Knockout Competitions, the following updates apply:

- Players must submit at least **two qualifying competition rounds** plus **one other play card** in the last 12 months to be eligible to win.
- Players who do not meet the criteria may participate but cannot win.
- Knockout competitions require the minimum criteria for entry.

• From Autumn 2025, all players entering club competitions must have a current WHS handicap and have played a minimum of three qualifying competition rounds in the previous 12 months.

Knockout Entries - Closing Date: Monday 24th March

If you haven't signed up yet, there's still time! This year, we've reintroduced **The Copper Knockout** (Handicap range 29.0-36.0)—a great opportunity for newer or returning players.
